## Goal and objectives

The tournament aims to promote and develop judo, identify young promising athletes, and honor the legacy of distinguished judokas.

## Competition organizers

The competition will be conducted by the Kutaisi Municipality City Hall and a panel of judges approved by the Georgian National Judo Federation.

## Competition participants

Male judokas born in 2008 will be allowed to compete. Participants can register on the Georgian Judo Federation website. All participants must have an ID card at the time of weigh-in.

# Conditions, time and place of the competition

The competition will be held on December 17-18, 2025 at the Tskaltubo Sports Palace.

Arrival day - December 16

Departure day - December 19

The draw will take place after the weigh-ins.

Competition starts at 10:00.

# Registration

Judokas can register only on the Georgian Judo Federation website (<a href="http://gif.ge/geo/calendar/georgia">http://gif.ge/geo/calendar/georgia</a>) by filling out a special registration form.

Only those athletes whose personal trainers electronically complete the registration form by December 10 will be allowed to compete.

The list of participants will be published on the federation's website on December 13. Coaches are required to verify their judokas and immediately notify the organizing committee of any inaccuracies.

Judokas without registration will not be allowed to compete.

# **Competition System**

Competition will be held According to Rules International Judo Federation and Georgian Judo Federation.

The competition will be held in 8 weight categories:

December 17:-55 kg, -60 kg, -66 kg, -73 kg,

December 18:-81 kg, -90 kg, -100 kg, +100 kg.

# Weighing

Weigh-in will be held by weight categories the day before the competition at the Sport Palace in Tskaltubo and at the Judo Academy in Tbilisi.

Unofficial 16:30 - 17:00; Official 17:00 - 18:00.

#### Awarding of the winners

In each weight category, the winning athletes will be awarded medals of the corresponding rank and certificates.

# Competition expenses

The travel, accommodation, and meal expenses of athletes, coaches, and team representatives will be covered by the delegating organizations.

The competition expenses (venue services, organizational matters, referees' fees and accommodation, medical staff fees, etc.), as well as the hotel costs for 1 coach and 2 athletes from each foreign delegation, will be covered by the Organizing Committee.

The regulation is considered an official invitation to the competition.
