Referees	All teams of three competitors or more must be accompanied by 1 referee. The organiser may register up to 4 referees. All referees must have at least continental license and classified A or B. This is the condition to participate in this tournament to meet the EJU requirements. The referees meeting will take place at the Hotel " <b>Courtyard Marriott</b> " <b>at 19.00 on Friday 28<sup>th</sup> January 2011.</b>			
Competition Rules	All IJF / EJU member federations can present 4 athletes maximum per weight category			
	The tournament will be carried out according to the rules and regulations of the IJF/EJU, KO system with quarter-final (last 8) repechage on 2 mats. Finals will be on 1 mat. The top 8 among the entered competitors according to the World Ranking List will be seeded. The rest of the draw will be separated by Nations.			
	The duration of the contests will be of 5 minutes, and 3 minutes for Golden Score.

	- For the final block program (TV time): jacket suit with tie.			

	The following are forbidden at any time: shorter trousers, sleeveless tops, undressed upper body, any kind of head caps and cover, jeans, sweaters or similar sports unrelated dress, flip-flops.				
Judogi	Blue and white Judogi will be required. The size of Judogi should be according to sokuteiki and publicity in accordance with IJF/EJU rules. Only Judogi from IJF suppliers will be allowed.				
	All competitors must have the official EJU / IJF Back Number (ordered from <u>www.mybacknumber.com</u> ). The sponsor part will be provided by the organizers during accreditation. Competitors who still have the 2010 version of the Back Number will be allowed to compete in this year's edition of the World Cup. From 2012, only the new version of the Back Number will be allowed. If the Judogi of the athlete does not comply with all the specifications of the EJU and the IJF, including the name and country patch, the athlete will be disqualified from the tournament.
